The Cameron County Tax Office is collecting property taxes at all seven (7) Lone Star National Bank locations in Cameron County, a property tax statement is required in order to pay.

Drive-thru lanes are also available at the following locations: 835 E. Levee St. Brownsville, TX, 3302 Wilson Rd. and 300 E. Van Buren Ave. Harlingen, TX, 199 S. Sam Houston Blvd. San Benito, TX, 745 W. Ocean Blvd. Los Fresnos, TX, 505 Highway 100 Port Isabel, TX.

Drop-off boxes conveniently accessible 24/7 for tax payments paid by check or money orders only may be dropped off at the Brownsville Main Office on East Levee between E. 8th Street and E. 9th Street in Brownsville, the Port Isabel Branch Office at 505 Highway 100, or at the new Los Fresnos Branch Office located at 745 W. Ocean Blvd.
