## NOTICE OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD BY THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE, TEXAS

TIME AND PURPOSE OF ELECTION: The City of Brownsville, Texas (the "City") will hold a General Municipal Election and Special Election between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on Saturday, May 6, 2023, in the City to fill the vacancies resulting from the expiration of the terms of office for Mayor, Commissioner At-Large"A", Commissioner District 1, and Commissioner District 2, and amending the Charter of the City of Brownsville, amending Article V, Section 13 and Section 22 and adding

Section 21-A; amending Article VI, Section 1 (c), Section 1 (e), and Section 1 (f).

This Charter Amendment Election is on the questions of adopting six (6) amendments to the Home Rule Charter as follows, and more specifically listed below: PROVIDING MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS WITH ANNUAL PAY; INCREASE CITY MANAGER'S CONTRACT TERMS; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CITY ATTORNEY; AMENDING TO ALLOW A TWO-THIRDS SUPERMAJORITY TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE BROWNSVILLE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD; ALLOWING A TWO-THIRDS SUPERMAJORITY TO REMOVE THREE BOARD MEMBERS FROM BROWNSVILLE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD IN ANY 12 MONTH PERIOD; AMENDING TO DECLARE A BROWNSVILLE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD MEMBER'S POSITION VACANT, OTHER THAN THE MAYOR WHO SERVES AS AN EX-OFFICIO; AFTER MISSING 4 REGULAR MEETINGS IN A CALENDAR YEAR, AND RELATED MATTERS.

PLACE OF ELECTION: For the purpose of holding said election, the City is divided into fifty-one(51) election precincts. Such election precincts have numbers and boundaries identical to those of the corresponding CameronCounty election precincts, except that the boundaries of the City election precincts exclude areas outside the City. The polling places for the City election precincts are consolidated into the following nineteen (19) locations, which are grouped by the four (4) City Electoral Districts.
