

Stage 2 Water Restrictions Initiated

BPUB activates **Stage 2 of Drought Contingency Plan** when Amistad and Falcon water reservoir levels reach 25%.



Water restrictions:

- Vehicle washing reduced to only 2 days a week from midnight to 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. to midnight.
- Non-essential watering is prohibited, such as washing buildings, using water for dust control, or allowing water to runoff into streets.
- Lawn watering by a sprinkler system is restricted to two days a week based on the last digit of the service area from midnight to 7 a.m. and from 7 p.m. to midnight.

Last # of Service Address	Watering Days
0 or 1	Monday, Saturday
2 or 3	Tuesday, Saturday
4 or 5	Wednesday, Saturday
6 or 7	Thursday, Sunday
8 or 9	Friday, Sunday

- Variances must be acquired from BPUB to water new landscapes outside the landscape irrigation schedule for 4 weeks.

Goal: 5% reduction in average daily water demands

Other Savvy Ways to Save Water:

- Check your toilet, faucets, and pipes for leaks.
- Limit your time in the shower.
- Turn off the water while brushing your teeth or shaving.
- Wait to use your dishwasher or washing machine until you have full loads.
- Use a broom or blower to clean sidewalks or driveways, not the hose.
- Water trees and shrubs using a hand-held hose or drip system.
- Use a bucket and sponge instead of a hose to wash your car.
