
MY NAME IS CLOUD & I NEED YOUR HELP....



Hello, my name is Carly Hauser. I live just down the road in Yellow Springs, Ohio with my partner Devin Brown. In May 2021, my we rescued 6-year-old Cloud, a white husky mix with a silver lining of hair down his back. I found him limping on his front leg, most likely due to being hit by a car. We had his front leg surgically repaired.

Cloud is an exceptionally beautiful dog, both inside and out. He is probably the gentlest dog I have ever known. He is no stranger to anyone. He has a wonderful personality – he is both friendly and affectionate to everyone.

Unfortunately, this fall Cloud developed a limp on his back left leg. He was ultimately diagnosed with bone cancer. On October 25, Cloud had his leg amputated. The surgery costed around \$7,400. Cloud will need to have at least six rounds of chemotherapy. The total cost for both treatments and exams will exceed \$10,000. The cost of both surgery and these treatments will be around \$18,000.

This is becoming a financial burden on us.

This letter is a plea to call on dog lovers for help to share this financial burden by giving any amount of money for Cloud. Anything you can give, even if it's \$1.00, would be greatly appreciated.
