- Provide intensive training for all school personnel in school safety as well as increased awareness of the school spectrum of mental health and behavioral issues that can lead to violence if unaddressed.
- Learn from local, state and federal events regarding best practices to manage internal and external threats to school and employee safety, and
- Support additional state and federal funds to increase the number of school counselors, improve security infrastructure, and provide for school improvement and training materials to further secure our schools.
