Policy of Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Disability Notice

Citizen Participation & Grievance Procedures Notice

The County of Cameron has adopted complaint and grievance procedures regarding its Texas Community Development Block Grant Programs (TxCDBG). These procedures outline the steps for a citizen to follow if s/he wishes to file a complaint or grievance about TxCDBG activities.

A person who has a complaint or grievance about any services or activities with respect to the TxCDBG project, may during regular business hours submit such complaint or grievance, in writing to the Civil Rights Officer, at 1100 E. Monroe Street Brownsville, TX. 78520 Suite 218 or may call 956-544-0828. Cameron County will make every effort to respond fully to such complaints within fifteen (15) working days where practicable.
