Education Required for Position: bachelor's degree in business administration or a related field from an accredited University.

License/Certification: Attainment of Professional Procurement Certification within 18 months of hire.

Experience Required for Position: Three (3) years of purchasing experience.

Preferred: Purchasing experience in a state agency, school, or University. Knowledge of State Purchasing Policies and Guidelines. Experience in the Implementation of Procurement software experience, including ERP systems. Experience with State Reporting (Legislative Budget Board) and HUB Program.
