

**NOTICE TO CLAIMANTS OF COMPLAINT FOR  
EXONERATION FROM ORUMITATION OF LIABILITY**


Notice is given that Pilot VII Services Inc. (“Pilot VII Services” or “Petitioner”), as owner of the M/V PILOT VII, has filed a Complaint, claiming the right to limitation of and/ or exoneration from liability for all claims arising out of the voyage on which the M/V PILOT VII was engaged on or about April 5, 2023, while docked in the navigable waters of the United States near Port Isabel, Texas.

Harrison St., #101, Brownsville Texas 78520, and serve on or mail to the attorneys for Petitioner, David Pybus of Kean Miller LLP 711 Louisiana Street, Suite 1800, Houston, Texas 77002 and Bradley J. Schlotterer and David T. Judd of Kean Miller LLP 909 Poydras Street, Suite 3600, New Orleans, Louisiana, 70112, copies thereof, on or before March 18, 2024 or be defaulted. Personal attendance is not required. Any claimant desiring to contest either the right of Petitioner to limitation of and/ or exoneration from liability must file an Answer to said Complaint as required by the aforesaid Supplemental Rule F and serve on or mail to the Petitioner’s attorney, a copy, unless the claim has included an Answer.
