PUBLIC NOTICE

Non-Compliance with Industrial Pretreatment Standards

The Federal Clean Water Act established the National Pretreatment Program to control the discharge from Industrial users into the sanitary sewer system operated by the Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTWs). Under delegation from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Brownsville Public Utilities Board (BPUB) has been given the responsibility for applying and enforcing the pretreatment standards for industrial users served by the Brownsville Public Utilities Board.

Pursuant to the requirements of the 40 CFR 403, BPUB must annually publish a list of industrial users within its service area that have either demonstrated a pattern of noncompliance with applicable pretreatment standards or had a significant noncompliance incident over the previous 12 months.

This notice has been issued to meet the requirement to inform the public.

Period covered by this notice: April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024

During this period Trimac Transportation (Permit No. 01-442-LT-1023-0225) located on 2020 North Central Avenue was found to be in significant non-compliance with the Oil and Grease daily average concentration limit.
