Unknown Trustees of Cameron County Consolidated Common School District Number One, their assigns and successors. as shown in Deed dated January 24, 1957, recorded in V634, P181, Deed Records of Cameron County, Texas, et al.* The Plaintiff is the State of Texas. The Defendants are: Unknown Trustees of Cameron County Consolidated Common School District Number One, their assigns and successors, as shown in Deed dated January 24, 1957, recorded in V634, P181, Deed Records of Cameron County, Texas, and, if any of them be deceased, their respective heirs and legal representatives, if any; Cameron County, Texas; South Texas Independent School District; and San Benito Independent School District.

The interests of these Defendants are that they either own or claim an interest in said property, subject to unpaid accrued taxes.

You are further notified that you may appear at the hearing before the special commissioners and present evidence you desire on the issue of damages to be assessed against the State. If you do not appear at the hearing, the Special Commissioners may proceed to assess the damages of the owner of the property being condemned.

If this Notice is not served within ninety (90) days after its issuance, it shall be returned forthwith.
