

STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AT VALLEY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Valley International Airport invites interested firms to submit a Statement of Qualifications for Construction Materials Engineering & Testing Services, Geotechnical Engineering Services, and Environmental Professional Services for various projects that will be designed for the next five (5) years at Valley International Airport.
