4, and 5 will have the right to vote in this election.
3. The City Secretary is authorized to give or cause to be  
given notices as necessary of the Special Run-Off Election  
and to take other additional steps to conduct the election in  
accordance with the Texas Local Government Code and Texas  
Election Code, provided, however, in accordance with the  
Election Agreements between Cameron County and the City;  
Cameron County Election Officials shall have the duty and  
responsibility to organize and conduct elections in accordance  
with the Texas Election Code; and for the provision of all the  
services specified in the Electoral Agreement. County Election  
Officials shall give such notices as may be required by the  
Texas Election Code.
