This application was submitted to the TCEC on May 17, 2023. The proposed facility will emit the following contaminants: carbon monoide, nitrogen oxides, organic compounds, particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less and sulfur dioxide.
