All funding decisions by the Board will be based on the project, its scope, impact on

the community, evaluation criteria, and any other factors the Board determines. Projects approved by the BCIC Board Of Directors will require additional approval by the Brownsville City Commission. Approved project(s) cannot begin, nor can any expenses be incurred, until the project agreement has been executed.
