Relays pertinent information to dispatcher and ED concerning patient's condition and generates and maintains necessary patient records of each patient and/or call. Maintains vehicles and equipment in optimum condition.

Education: Graduate of an accredited School of Professional EMS Technology.

Personal Job-Related Skills: Effective verbal and written communication skills. Familiarity with operation of emergency medical services vehicles and equipment.

Licensure, Registry or Certification: Current certification by the Texas Department of Health as an Emergency Medical Technician Paramedic. Current Driver's License. Current CPR certification required. ACLS, PALS, PHTLS, etc., preferred.
