INVITATION TO BIDDERS

UNITED IRRIGATION DISTRICT is accepting sealed bid proposals to construct the FM 494, Mile 3 to Mile 5 Pipeline Relocation.

SEALED PROPOSALS addressed to Mr. Jesus Garcia, President, at the office of United Irrigation District, of Hidalgo County, P.O. Box 877 (2 Mile Line, $\frac{3}{4}$ West), Mission, Texas, 78572, will be received until Wednesday, December 10, 2025, at 11:00 AM, for furnishing all materials, supplies, and labor necessary for the construction of FM 494 Mile 3 to Mile 5 Pipeline Relocation, in accordance with the specifications on file at District Office. At the time stated, bids will be publicly opened and read at the District Office. A Pre-Bid conference will be held Wednesday, December 3, 2025, at 11:00 AM, at the office of United Irrigation District (2 Mile Line, $\frac{3}{4}$ West), Mission, Texas, 78572.

PLANS may be examined without charge at the District Office or to the office of Ferris, Flinn & Medina, LLC. Complete Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents may be obtained at the office of Ferris, Flinn & Medina, LLC, Telephone (956) 364-2236, for a nonrefundable cost of \$150.00 for each printed set, and/or \$75.00 for each electronic set. Each bidder is responsible for making sure they are on the Bidders List maintained by Ferris, Flinn, & Medina, LLC.

A CERTIFIED OR CASHIER'S CHECK, or an acceptable bid bond in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the total bid shall accompany each bid as a guaranty that, if awarded the Contract, the bidder will promptly enter into each contract with United Irrigation District and furnish bonds on the forms provided.

BIDDERS are expected to inspect the site of the work and to inform themselves of all local conditions. All work shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) calendar days after receipt of Notice to Proceed.

United Irrigation District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any or all informalities, and to award the contract to the bidder or bidders, who, in the opinion of the District offers the proposal in its best interest. The prices submitted will be unit prices and the award will be based on the estimated quantity of work outlined in the bid form considering the work the Owner will actually perform. **The work includes material, labor and equipment necessary to construct approximately 6,600 feet of new relocated irrigation pipeline, including earthwork, reinforced concrete gate wells, existing irrigation facilities removal, backfill, excavation, dry bore, and any other incidentals necessary for a complete and operable system in Mission, Texas. Steel and Iron material shall be Buy America compliant.**

BIDDERS are cautioned that conditional or qualified bids, or bids not in the proper form may be rejected.
