Total revenue for 2023: \$1,238,912.00
- In 2024, he had his clerks cross trained in civil and criminal The office became more efficient in staying caught up and work being done in a timely manner. Class C warrants issued 2,960.
Total Revenue for 2024 \$1,405,723.00
- In 2025, Justice of the Peace Pct. 1 teamed up With PCT. 1 Constable office and Crime Stoppers to bring in people who had unpaid warrants. Class C warrants issued 5,396.
