TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held in the Cameron County Drainage District No. 6 on November 4, 2025, as provided in an ORDER CALLING A DRAINAGE DISTRICT BOND ELECTION duly passed by the Board of Directors of said District on August 15, 2025 which Order is substantially

ORDER CALLING DRAINAGE DISTRICT BOND ELECTION

WHEREAS, CAMERON COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 6 (the "District") is a body politic and corporate and a governmental agency of the State of Texas, created by an election held on November 4, 2025, wherein a majority of the voters of the District voted in favor of creating the District. The District operates under and is governed by the provisions of Chapters 49 and 56, Texas Water

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the District, open to inspection by the public, an engineer's report covering the utility works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment and appliances to be purchased, constructed or otherwise acquired and constructed by the District and as well as the estimated cost of all the foregoing, together with maps, plats, profiles and data showing and explaining the report, and the report has been considered by the Board and has been fully approved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, said utility works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, appliances, property, contract rights, rights of use and interests in property are designed and intended to furnish a drainage and storm sewer system; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Directors of the District has determined that pursuant to the engineer's report an election should be held for the purpose of submitting a proposition on the issuance of the District's drainage bonds in the total aggregate amount of \$25,000,000 and the levying and collecting of an annual ad valorem tax to support the issuance of such drainage bonds; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Directors wishes to proceed with the ordering of said election.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CAMERON COUNTY DRAINAGE **DISTRICT NO. 6 THAT:**

Section 1: The matters and facts set out in the preamble of this Order are hereby found and declared to be true and complete.

Section 2: An election shall be held on November 4, 2025, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at any County Wide Voter Center designated by the Cameron County Elections Office as set out in the attached Exhibit "A" and as allowed by Section 43.007 of the Texas Election Code, at which time the following propositions shall be submitted to the voters:

PROPOSITION A

THIS IS A TAX INCREASE

SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CAMERON COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 6 BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT IN ONE OR MORE ISSUES OR SERIES IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$25,000,000 MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE IN SUCH INSTALLMENTS AS ARE FIXED BY SAID BOARD OVER A PERIOD OR PERIODS NOT EXCEEDING FORTY (40) YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, BEARING INTEREST AT ANY RATE OR RATES (FIXED VARIABLE, FLOATING, ADJUSTABLE, OR OTHERWISE), AND TO SELL SAID BONDS AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES, PROVIDED THAT THE NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE. ON ANY ISSUE OR SERIES OF SAID BONDS SHALL NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM LEGAL LIMIT NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, ALL AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAID DISTRICT, FOR DRAINAGE AND STORM WATER IMPROVEMENTS FOR SAID DISTRICT AND ANY SYSTEM MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT FOR SUCH IMPROVEMENTS AND PURCHASING OR OTHERWISE ACQUIRING ANY AND ALL PROPERTY, AND SHALL THE BOARD BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY AND PLEDGE, AND CAUSE TO BE ASSESSED AND COLLECTED, ANNUAL AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS THEY BECOME DUE, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS

Section 3: The Board of Directors have determined that in accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 3.009(b)(5), based on market conditions at the time of adoption of this Order, the estimated tax rate if the debt obligations are authorized is \$0.120 per \$100 valuation and the maximum interest rate of debt obligations or any series of debt obligations is 6.0%;

The Board of Directors have determined that in accordance with Texas Election Code. Section 3.009 (b)(7), the aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the District's debt obligations as of the beginning of the District's fiscal year in which this election is ordered is \$4,570,000.00;

The Board of Directors have determined that in accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 3.009 (b)(8), the aggregate amount of outstanding interest on debt obligations of the District as of the beginning of the District's fiscal year in which this election is ordered is \$1,087,250.00;

The Board of Directors have determined that in accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 3.009 (b)(9), the ad valorem debt service tax rate for the District, as of the date of this Order, is \$0.0918 per \$100 valuation of taxable property;

The statements contained in these findings above are based on information available to the District on the date of adoption of this Election order, including (i) information derived from projections obtained from the District's financial advisor, (ii) necessarily consist of estimates and projects that are subject to change based on facts, circumstances and conditions at the time that bonds approved pursuant to this Election Order are issued and (iii) are not intended to give rise to a contract with the voters or limit the authority of the Board to issue bonds in accordance with other terms contained in

this Election Order, Accordingly, actual tax rates, interest rates, maturity dates, aggregate outstanding indebtedness and interest on such debt will vary and will be established after the bonds are issued. To the extent of any conflict between this subsection and other terms of this Election Order, such

Section 4: Voting shall take place on Election Day between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M., at the polling places, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if copied in full.

Section 5: (a) The early voting clerk for said election shall be Remi Garza, Cameron County Elections Administrator. Early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail or other lawful means. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than Friday, October 24, 2025. Applications for ballots by mail for contract carrier delivery, as well as marked ballots, should be sent to the following address:

Section 6: The election will be conducted under an Election Agreement for Election Services with Cameron County, Texas (the "County") with the County Elections Administrator.

Section 7: The ballots used in the election shall have printed thereon the following, in addition to instructions for making such ballot:

Section 14: All orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Order shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordered herein.

Section 15: This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.

Section 16: If any provision of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Order and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and this Court hereby declares that this Order would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

Section 17: It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Order is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Order, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
