The **City of Santa Rosa** will receive bids for the **Ovalle Lateral Drainage Improvements Santa Rosa, Texas GLO Contractor No. 24-067-041-E229** until **3:00p.m. on December 18th, 2025.** at **411 6th Street, Santa Rosa, TX 78593.** The bids will be publicly opened at said time and read aloud at **City Hall of Santa Rosa - 411 6th Street, Santa Rosa, TX 78593** at **3:00 p.m.** Bids received after the closing time will be returned unopened. Bids must be addressed to: Jared Hockema, City Manager.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. Approximately 7,218 CY of excavation and hauling of ditch material
2. Inlets and RCP storm sewer
3. Asphalt street repairs for installation of RCP

Copies of the Contract Documents, including Plans and Project Manual, Bidding Documents, Conditions of the Contract for Construction, and Specifications may be obtained at the Expressway Print Shop located at 2020 E. Expressway 83, Mercedes Texas 78570 Suite 4, Phone: (956) 825-9829. A deposit of \$200 non-refundable can be made payable to Expressway Print Shop.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Santa Rosa or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The project to be constructed will be financed with assistance from the General Land Office (GLO) under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program and is subject to all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations. Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing DavisBacon and Related Acts wage rate, as issued by the Department of Labor and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin. Adherence to the City of Santa Rosa Section 3 Policy is required for all contracts.

All contractors and subcontractors must be cleared (not suspended or debarred) prior to any formal action authorizing the award of a contract to the contractor. Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Section 3 Businesses, and labor surplus area firms are encouraged to submit bids.

The **City of Santa Rosa** reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by City of Santa Rosa for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
