**PUBLIC NOTICE
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS AND NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
OF FUNDS HOME-AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN PROGRAM**

The City of Brownsville's Grants & Community Development is requesting local supportive service providers to submit a program application to participate in the City of Brownsville HOME-ARP Program. The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 appropriated \$5 billion to provide housing, services, and shelter to individuals experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable populations. Funds must primarily benefit individuals and households of the qualifying populations experiencing homelessness, at-risk of homelessness, fleeing domestic violence, and other populations with high risk of housing instability.

Approved projects will receive funding through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's HOME-ARP allocation to the City of Brownsville for eligible activities included under Supportive Services. A total of \$749,811.78 in HOME-ARP funding will be available for the 2026 fiscal year.

Deadline to submit a complete application is Friday, February 13, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Central Time. Application has to be submitted with Amplifund following the application instructions. Failure to meet the submission deadline (no later than 5:00pm Central Time on February 13th.) will preclude a proposal from consideration by the City of Brownsville.

Additionally, a pre-bid virtual meeting will be held on **Thursday, January 8th, 2026 from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m** over Microsoft Teams and in-person meeting **Thursday, January 29th, 2026** at the Brownsville Public Library Main Branch's Main Meeting room (2600 Central Blvd) from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. to provide technical assistance and to answer general questions regarding the completion of the application and the application process.
