



## **PEST CONTROL MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

### **VALLEY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT HARLINGEN, TEXAS**

**APRIL 2026**

The City of Harlingen, Valley International Airport (Airport), is currently requesting bids for monthly (and as needed) pest control management services for the airport facility, including terminals, administrative Offices, and surrounding grounds.

Pest control management services should include a control plan covering insects, rodents, roaches, ants, silverfish, mice, rats, spiders, and other pests.

These services are sought to protect the health and safety of airport staff, passengers, visitors, tenants, and concessionaires. In addition, these services will prevent damage to airport property and assets and ensure compliance with all local, state, and federal regulations related to pest control and environmental safety.

The following minimum requirements must be met in order for a company to provide pest management services for the Airport:

- (1) Firm name, address, phone number, and contact person.
- (2) Possess a valid commercial pest control license in the State of Texas.
- (3) Provide proof of appropriate insurance (general liability and workers' compensation).
- (4) Minimum of five (5) years of experience in commercial or airport pest control.
- (5) Compliance with FAA and TSA safety and security regulations.
- (6) Ability to work in secure and restricted areas.
- (6) Adequate staffing and equipment to service the airport's needs.

The selected contractor/firm will ensure a safe, sanitary, and pest-free environment throughout the airport facility in compliance with all applicable federal, state, local, and TSA rules and regulations, including monthly routine inspections and treatments, Integrated Pest Management (IPM) practices to minimize chemical use, emergency pest control services upon request, detailed service reports after each visit, and reporting of all treatments and inspections.

The contract period is for twelve (12) consecutive months commencing on June 1, 2026, and ending on May 31, 2027, with the option to renew for an additional four (4) years at one (1) year intervals as long as both parties agree in writing under the same terms, conditions, and costs.

All bids must be submitted by 2:00 PM, Monday, April 22, 2026. Bids submitted after that time will not be opened and returned to the sender.
