Reallocation Program (DRRP)

2018 South Texas Floods (DR-4377)

The City of Mission, Texas ("City") submitted an application for infrastructure funding to the General Land Office ("GLO") Disaster Recovery Reallocation Program ("DRRP") 2018 South Texas Floods.

In accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan and Texas General Land Office (GLO) requirements, the City is providing notice of the public comment period and public hearing for the submitted DRRP application. Members of the public are strongly encouraged to participate in this process.

The public comment period will be open from July 11, 2026, until July 24, 2026.

On June 23, 2026, the Mission City Council adopted Resolution No. 2064 authorizing the submission of a DRRP application requesting \$2,000,000 in grant funding with a \$200,000 (10%) local match. The City submitted the application on June 26, 2026, under application title DRRP-231-1289. The proposed project includes the rehabilitation of Holland Road (from West Expressway 83 to West 9th Street) and adjacent streets (Walsh Avenue, Perez Street, and West 1st Street) to improve roadway resilience, restore reliable access to residential neighborhoods, enhance public health and safety, reduce flood-related impacts, and support the long-term recovery and resilience of housing following the 2018 South Texas Floods.

A public hearing will be held at 2:00 p.m. on July 17, 2026 at the offices of the City of Mission City Hall located at 1201 East 8th St., Mission, TX 78572. Members of the public can attend these public hearings in person, telephonically, or via Zoom. To attend the public hearing telephonically or via Zoom, please coordinate with Michael J.
